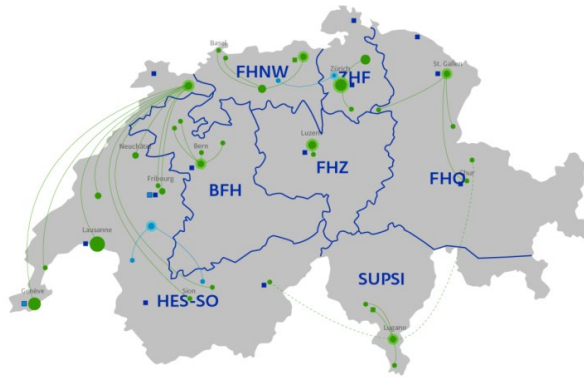

The Department of innovative technologies accomplishes this role by training young engineers, supporting the professional update of companies' technical staff, and supporting companies through applied research and technology transfer

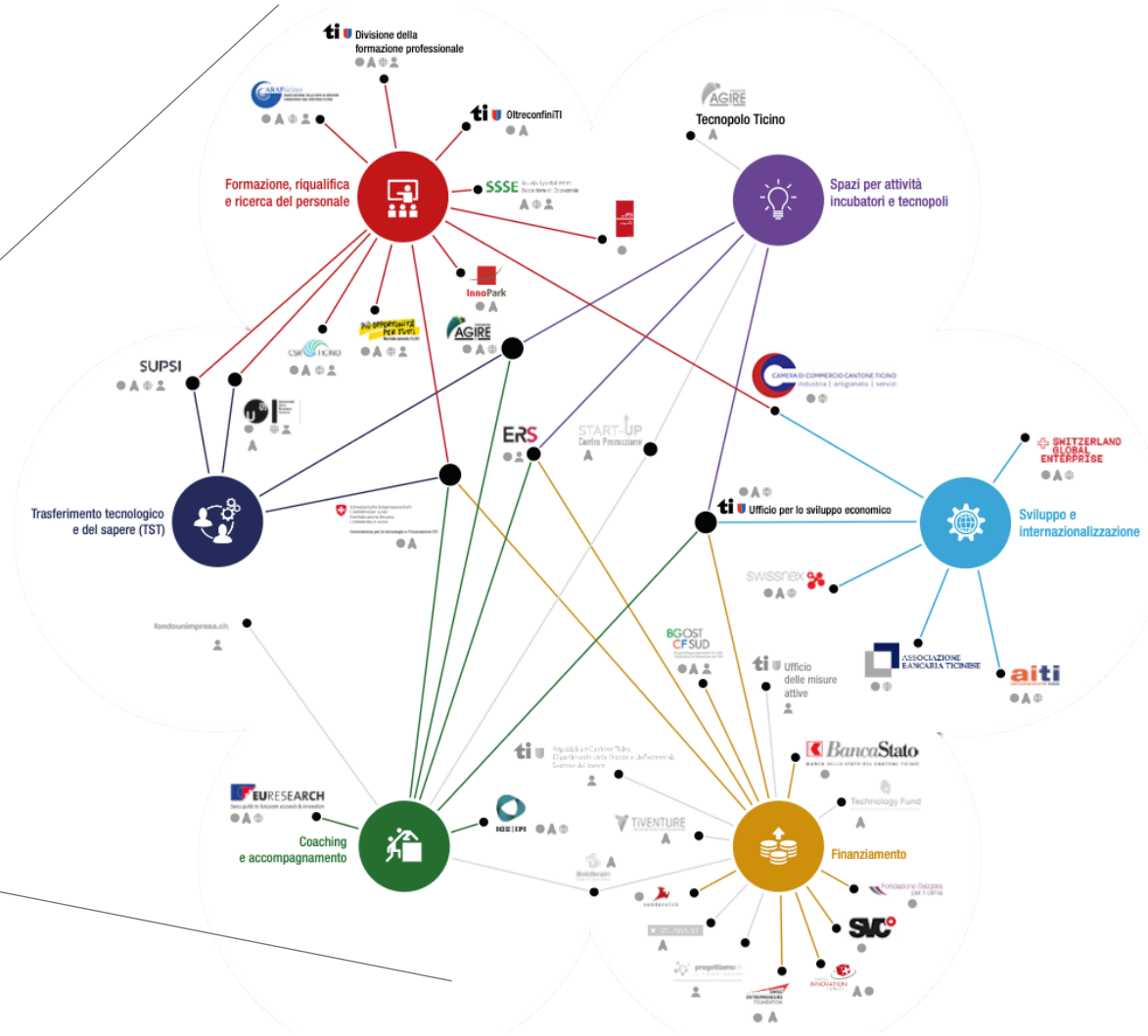
The territory
